
Skagit Valley College offers a wide variety of tutoring help. At both the Mount Vernon and Whidbey Island campuses, you can "drop-in" for math tutoring during the scheduled hours. This help is available at no cost to any registered Skagit Valley student. Check each campus for the scheduled hours. You can also schedule 25-minute sessions with writing tutors. These tutors will NOT proof-read, but will point out mistakes and help you identify errors and fix them. In addition, you can schedule 30-minute sessions for ESL tutoring.

At the Mount Vernon campus these face-to-face tutors are available in Lewis Hall, Room L-20. At the Whidbey Island campus, the center is in Sprague Hall, Room S-6.

Some students may be eligible for the TRIO Student Support program. This federally funded program has several eligibility requirements. Check <u>HERE</u> for further information to determine if YOU meet the requirements.

ALL students at Skagit Valley College may use the FREE eTutoring services through the Northwest eTutoring Consortium. The services include a writing lab, eChat services for one-to-one help, and eQuestions where you can leave a specific question and have it answered within 48 hours. This service offers help in subjects from Accounting, through the sciences and math, to writing.

eTutoring Services

- eWriting Lab allows you to submit a draft of your paper to a tutor, ask for specific feedback, and receive your work back with an eTutor's response within 24-48 hours.
- Live tutoring via eChat allows you to meet with an eTutor in one-on-one tutoring sessions via a fully interactive, virtual online environment.
- Offline eQuestions allows you to leave a specific question in any subject for an eTutor. You will receive a response within 48 hours (usually sooner).

Please Note:

If you choose eChat, colored tutor icons will show which tutors are online. Click on the icon you wish to "chat" with. Note that your browser must be set to allow pop-ups in order for eChat to work.

If a tutor isn't available for eChat, you can leave the tutors an eQuestion.
